Revisions to Electronics course documents to add clarification on synoptic questions in exams

NEA Submission

The following NEA components are moving from postal submission to e-submission via our Internal Assessment Mark Input System (IAMIS) <u>from Summer 2026</u>.

- GCSE Electronics Component 3 (C490U30-1)
- AS Electronics Component 2 (B490U20-1)
- A level Electronics Component 3 (A490U30-1)

Instructions for e-submission via IAMIS

- Navigate to the screen where you input candidate outcomes for each component entry (Portal > All services > Examinations and Assessment > Internal Assessment/Marks Outcomes)
- 2. On the input screen, where candidate marks have been entered and samples generated, navigate to the far right column titled 'upload' and the cloud icon appears
- 3. Click the button and upload sample for each sample candidate. IAMIS will accept all standard file formats.

Revisions to Electronics course documents

The GCSE and A level Electronics specifications and Guidance for Teaching documents have been revised to add clarification on synoptic questions in exams. These questions require candidates to draw together knowledge, skills and understanding from across the full course of study.

Synoptic questions are set in all written exams. These questions require knowledge from both components (for GCSE and A level). Examples of synoptic questions are included in the Sample Assessment Materials.
