

Eduqas GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition: actions taken to mitigate processing error

We have contacted centres (11/10/2024) to confirm the actions we have undertaken to resolve a processing error which took place ahead of grades being awarded for GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition this summer.

Please accept our apologies for this error and for any inconvenience caused.

Nature of the error

Following the end of moderation for the NEA component, we failed to correctly process mark adjustments for centres whose marking was not aligned with the intended standard. This meant that some students did not receive the correct mark. As the distribution of marks was not correct, the resulting grade boundaries set at award were slightly misaligned, at grades 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2.

Actions taken

We have worked at pace to resolve this issue and to reduce the impact on students. We have made the decision to reprocess mark adjustments and to reprocess projected marks for students who were absent from one component, and re-evaluate the grade boundaries for this year's summer series, lowering the boundaries at affected grades by one mark. The final grade boundaries can be found on the Eduqas website.

Due to the scale of the issue, and the fact that we identified the problem well after results day, we have concluded that it would not be appropriate on this occasion to change the grades for students where they otherwise would be lower due to the reprocessing of marks.

Therefore, no students' grades will go down as a result of the changes we have made this week, but we have implemented upward grade changes where appropriate.

How does this affect you?

Certificates are due to be issued shortly. These will reflect the revised grades for students.
