### Subject webpage

The WJEC Entry Level English subject webpage on the WJEC website is the starting place for anyone teaching the specification and contains a range of official documentation relating to the qualification including the specification, sample assessment materials and past papers.

#### Portal

Portal gives teachers access to past papers and marking schemes ahead of their publication on the public website as well as access to other resources such as the NEA materials for Components 2 and 3.

For teachers to access Portal, they will need a username and password, which can be set up by their Examinations Officer.




### 1. Key Documents



### 2. Past Papers



Question papers from past examination series are available for:

- Section A: Non-literary Reading.
- Section B: Functional Writing.

#### Past papers on Portal (shortly after end of exam series)

Past papers are published initially on Portal shortly after the end of the examination series.

To locate the past papers, select 'Past Papers & Marking Schemes' from the 'Resources' menu at the top of the screen:



Then use the dropdown menus to choose the papers that you are looking for. Remember to select 'WJEC' in the brand drop-down.

Then use the dropdown menus to choose the marking schemes that you are looking for. Remember to put 'WJEC' in the brand dropdown:








#### **Annual CPD/ Professional Learning programme**
