NEA TASK FORMS

With the new academic year, a new cohort of learners are thinking of problems to solve with their NEA projects. All NEA task forms have a section for each learner's Task Focus to be signed off by the teacher at the start of the project. The electronics specifications at GCSE, AS and A level all state:

"Learners should be encouraged and supported to select tasks in which they are interested and which are neither under nor over ambitious. Each learner's task is to be signed off by the teacher. The teacher should discuss the proposed focus of the task with the learner, considering the requirements of the assessment and the ability and interests of the individual learner. The teacher must be satisfied that the suggested focus has the potential for the individual learner to:

- analyse the problem and derive a design specification;
- develop and test a range of sub-systems;
- develop, realise and test a final physical system;
- evaluate the final system against the design specification and suggest improvements.

This will help ensure the task is at a suitable level for the learner concerned and will provide that individual with a level of challenge that is appropriate to their abilities, in the context of the requirements of the Electronics qualification."
