

WJEC Level 1/ Level 2 Vocational Award (Technical Award) Grade Boundary and Unit information

There is a 40% terminal requirement which must be satisfied by the externally assessed unit. This means that if a candidate is cashing in to receive an overall grade for the qualification they **must** also be entered for the externally assessed unit in the same series.

The UMS achieved for the externally assessed unit attempted in the series in which the candidate is cashing in will be used in the calculation of the overall grade, even if this is lower than any previous attempt.
