






Access to Item Level Data

First you will need to navigate to the WJEC secure website (www.wjecservices.co.uk or from a link on the public website), and then login.





A window similar to that below will open








Item Level Summary (Candidates)



For each unit a candidate has sat, the mark achieved on each item is given.




ltem Level Summary (Candidates)



Click the 'DOWNLOAD DATA' icon for a complete set of candidate data that can be viewed and manipulated as a spread sheet




wjec Item Level Summary (Candidates)

- Average mark achieved for all candidates entered with WJFC





Centre Performance in Context



This gives (for each item) the **mean**, **facility factor** and **attempt %**, for all candidates as well as males and females separately.

- Identify the accessible and challenging questions for your centre and address them.


